Plymouth Middle School Experience

Plymouth Middle School has identified Critical Competencies which students are expected to demonstrate in reading, writing, listening, speaking, math, science, social studies and allied arts.

PMS is a Pre-Advanced Placement school. Students have the opportunity to take more rigorous and demanding courses that will help prepare them for the Advanced Placement (AP) courses offered at Robbinsdale Armstrong High School. Pre-AP is based on two important premises: that all students can perform at rigorous academic levels and that students are prepared for higher intellectual performance by starting the development of skills and knowledge as early as possible. Beginning with the 2013-14 school year, PMS will provide advanced placement preparation in all of its course offerings. Pre-AP teachers receive training from the College Board and meet with high school AP teachers to coordinate curriculum and ensure student success from one grade to the next.

The school works hard to meet the needs of all students. Students are placed on grade level teams which allow them to be a part of a smaller learning community. These smaller learning communities help students make the adjustment from elementary to middle school.

PMS offers a wide variety of athletic, academic, and service activities for students of all grade levels. Transportation is available

Outstanding Curriculum

The Core Curriculum

The core courses include math (assigned through geometry by readiness level), science, social studies, English, reading, Spanish and French. Support is available for students who need a little extra help.

The Allied Arts Curriculum

The Allied Arts courses include visual arts; Microsoft Office; family and consumer science; technology education, including Gateway to Technology (GTT) the middle level curriculum of the Project Lead the Way Engineering program; health education; AVID; physical education; band, choir and orchestra (or study hall if student is not in music).

Pre-Advanced Placement

Plymouth Middle School offers Pre-Advanced Placement courses. Pre-AP courses have entrance criteria and standards for students to maintain. Pre-AP course offerings are also available within the Spanish Immersion program.

AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination)

AVID is a college readiness elective designed to help students in the academic middle—especially those who will be the first in their family to attend college—prepare for and succeed in college, by accelerating student learning using research-based methods for instruction and motivation to succeed.
